The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the official stewards. If you come to the event on your own, please notify the organisers on arrival.

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - PLEASE NOTE - UPDATED FOR 2010

1. Events and competitions are unaffiliated unless stated otherwise. However, they will be run in accordance with the appropriate discipline rule books and in addition the rules set out below.
2. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that Malthouse Centre, Persons Acting on Their Behalf or Their Agents or Landowners shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury, accident, damage or illness to horses or other animals, owners, riders or spectators or any other person whatsoever, vehicle or property, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. It is recommended that all competitors have adequate personal and animal insurance. Owners/riders/handlers enter entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the organisers, judges or landowner of the show in any respect whatsoever.
3. It is a deemed a condition of entry that all competitors have inspected the ground/surface prior to entering and are happy to proceed.
4. Cheques should be made payable to **MALTHOUSE CENTRE**. Cheques Only Accepted With a Valid Cheque Guarantee Card.
5. Correct riding attire must be worn.
6. Correctly fitting headgear and boots with heels must be worn by anyone mounted on the showground. Headgear must conform to the current BHS safety standards and must be either PAS 015 or BSEN 1384 standard or be prefixed with AST or SEI and must have a three point harness. Spot checks may be carried out. Non compliance will result in elimination. This rule takes precedent over rules on headgear/footwear contained in any Rules of Affiliated bodies.
7. Back protectors are recommended for show jumping and compulsory for cross country. Medic Armbands **MUST** be worn for Cross Country.
8. Basic First Aid Facilities are provided by way of Qualified First Aiders. Ambulance cover is by 999 Call only so people ride at their own risk.
9. The judge's and/or organiser's decision is final
10. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without giving a reason and will return the entry fee accompanying such entry.
11. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter the event or published information.
12. The judges reserve the right to eliminate any unfit or unsound horse/pony. Any person, in the opinion of an event official, seen ill treating a horse/pony will be required to leave the showground immediately and partake in no further competitions at that event regardless of any entry fee being paid.
13. No horse or pony under 4 years of age may be ridden at the event.
14. No Canter/ing Outside of the warm up areas and arenas.
15. Entry fees will only be refunded on the production of a medical or veterinary certificate.
16. Horse/Ponies are not to be left unattended when tied up to trailers or lorries in the car park.
17. Children must be properly supervised at all times.
18. Please do not leave any rubbish, droppings etc. on the showground.
19. Failure to ring for times (when this is a requirement of the entry) will constitute a withdrawal.
20. If dogs are permitted on the showground, they must be kept on a lead.
